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## View Your Medicare Summary Notice (MSN) on [mymedicare.gov](https://my.medicare.gov)

Medicare mails you a Medicare Summary Notice (MSN) every three months, at the end of each calendar quarter, if you have had services or medical supplies billed to Medicare during that three-month period.

Your MSN includes the following key information:

- Amount charged by provider, facility, or supplier,
- Amount Medicare approves under its fee schedule,
- Amount paid by Medicare,
- Maximum remaining amount you may be billed by the facility, provider, or supplier, and
- Amount you can expect to owe when you receive the provider's bill.

Want to see this information sooner than every three months? You can view your MSN at [mymedicare.gov](https://my.medicare.gov), usually within 24 hours after Medicare processes the claim.

Once you register and log in to [mymedicare.gov](https://my.medicare.gov), follow these steps to view your MSN:

- Search your claims,
- View a specific claim, and
- Click on the 'View MSN' link located below the Claim Number on the Claim Details page.

Note: If your claim has been adjusted, you must call 1-800-MEDICARE (1-800-633-4227) to order a copy of the MSN.
