



Your Express Scripts Medicare Part D Prescription Drug Plan

Important updates for 2018

Get the most from your 2018 prescription drug plan. Carefully review this summary of enhancements, resources and changes.

NEW preferred pharmacy network

In 2018, you'll pay the same copays as you did in 2017 when you fill prescriptions at one of the more than 31,000 retail pharmacies in the new **Medicare Preferred Value Network**.

The **Medicare Preferred Value Network** includes large retail chains, such as Albertson's, Costco, Giant Eagle, Kmart, Rite Aid, Safeway, Tops, Walgreens, Walmart and others.

You can still fill your prescriptions at a pharmacy that does not participate in the **Medicare Preferred Value Network, but you will pay more.**

Note: Copays above apply after \$100 deductible is met.

Why are plan changes like the new preferred pharmacy network necessary?

These cost containment changes are necessary to enable ITDR to continue meeting its goal of offering an affordable plan while facing an explosion of new classes of specialty drugs approved in recent years (and currently in the pipeline for 2018 and beyond), as well as the impact of the Affordable Care Act and other federal mandates.

ITDR Low Cost Generics Program updates

The Pharmacy Network for the ITDR Low Cost Generics Program will change in 2018 to the new Medicare Preferred Value Network (see page 1). Continue to pay only \$2 or \$4 for a 31-day supply of some of the most commonly prescribed generic drugs. in all coverage stages.

Top 10 drugs used in the ITDR **Low Cost Generics Program**

- 1. Atorvastatin calcium 6. Metformin Hcl
- 2. Levothyroxine sodium 7. Pravastatin sodium
- 3. Lisinopril
- 8. Hydrochlorothiazide
- 4. Simvastatin
- 9. Losartan potassium
- 5. Furosemide
- 10. Carvedilol

All generic drugs filled at Standard Network Pharmacies will be charged the standard retail copay.

Locating a Preferred pharmacy

From express-scripts.com:

Select "Find a Pharmacy" from the menu under Prescriptions. Enter the ZIP code or City/State where you wish to find a pharmacy. The search results provide a map and list showing nearby pharmacies with address and contact information. Click a letter to find pharmacies alphabetically.

From the Express Scripts mobile app:

Select "Locate a Pharmacy" from the main menu. Enter the ZIP code, City/State, or "Current location." The search results provide a map showing nearby pharmacies. In-network pharmacies are indicated with a star, while Preferred pharmacies are indicated with a "P." Click on the marker to see the pharmacy name.
